Steve raising money for Headway whilst challenging world records

Steve Hodge, an avid cyclist from Ormskirk decided to take on one of cycling's toughest challenges whilst hoping to raise awareness of **Headway.**



Having cycled all of his life, Steve has many cycling achievements under his belt

including Coast to Coast and back in under 1 day and Ormskirk to Inverness covering 365miles in 1 day. Steve decided to challenge the current world record for cycling from **Lands end to John O'Groats and back!** This is currently held by Joe Rockett and stands at 5days, 21hours, 8mins.

Steve was supported during the attempt by a team of friends including his friend Jan Johnston who he was with when he and a life changing cycle accident in 2012. Jan suffered severe head injuries and it is for this reason that Steve decided to raise money for Headway – being amazed at the support provided by the Headway charity in the North West during Jan's rehabilitation. It was also important to raise awareness of bike helmet safety.





Unfortunately Steve did not manage to beat the time record and was plagued with injuries throughout the course. But what an achievement and inspiration!
